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David – we think this will function from an operational standpoint. As it happens, the morning peak-hours for egress at Dogwood Place coincide with the morning lull for egress at Dogwood Festival; likewise, the heavy afternoon peak egress at Festival coincides with the afternoon lull at Dogwood Place. We agree that the splitter island should be extended to the south.

We strongly recommend keeping the northbound lane assignments at Dogwood Festival as they currently are in the construction plans (left only, thru-left, right only). We have heard that a triple NB left is being considered but, due to the daily traffic demands described above and our expectation that this connector will be underutilized, we do not want the free-right turn lane taken away from the heavy afternoon NB right turn demand.

The most recent 12-hour turning movement counts are attached for reference along with a recommended signing and pavement marking plan.
