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Greetings, gentlemen. Looks like the frontage road connecting Dogwood Festival and Dogwood Place has been resurrected. We've been asked to look at this from an operations and a cost perspective. I know you will not like what you see in the attached, but I guess the big question is will it function. It has changed from last year – now we're looking at a one-way operation (single 11' lane) to get traffic to the signal at Dogwood Festival. I've angled the frontage road and omitted a turning radius where it ties in near the signal to discourage wrong-way movements, but I think the existing island may need to be extended to the south. There is approximately 75' from the stop bar to the frontage road, but I have no idea what the max queue lengths are to determine if the frontage road will get blocked up by traffic leaving the shopping center. Can you guys please take a look at this and let me know what you think? Amy asked us to look at this, and we have been given one month to do so. This includes coming up with big-ticket pay item quantities, cost estimate, and forwarding to ROW Division for their estimate. With that said, please evaluate this as quickly as possible so we can get everything completed on time. If you need any CADD drawings or anything else, please let me know and I'll take care of it. Thank you for your help.
