Victims of Human Trafficking and Commercial Sexual Exploitation Fund

Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 99-19-75(2), \$1,000.00 assessments “**shall** be imposed and collected from each person upon whom a court imposes a fine or other penalty for any violation of” the following – for both felony and misdemeanors:

Miss. Code Ann. § 97-3-7 – Simple and aggravated assault; simple and aggravated domestic violence

Miss. Code Ann. § 97-3-54.1 – Human Trafficking

Miss. Code Ann. § 97-3-65 – Statutory rape; forcible sexual intercourse

Miss. Code Ann. § 97-3-95 – Sexual battery

Miss. Code Ann. § 97-5-1 et seq. – Offenses affecting children

Miss. Code Ann. § 97-29-51 – Procuring prostitution

** Note, these are in addition to assessments for the Mississippi Children’s Trust Fund and the convictions are for all victim types.
